Direct Service Opportunities

Be a life-line for someone in need. Help answer the 24-hour crisis line. Participate in support group facilitation, help out at one of our confidential shelters or accompany a survivor to court. Direct service volunteers must attend the 20 hour training.

Direct Service Training Cost

\$100 for the entire training or \$20 per class. Background check required for all positions.

Support Service Opportunities

Help our admin teams stay organized in the office by volunteering with basic office support or join the Resource Development Office and volunteer at one of our annual fundraising events. Basic office work and special events do not require the full training.
